Fantastic Teeth Fan Club partnered with 637 Masonic Lodges and 1,784 elementary schools to provide 149,221 dental hygiene kits to Texas children, bringing our grand total to date to 1,425,745.

Child and Family Program provided services to 866 children for medical care, dental treatments and procedures, autism-related therapies, and basic needs such as rent and utilities, and more.

MCFS Scholarship Program has grown tremendously. The first year we awarded thirty (30) \$2,500 scholarships to Texas High School Seniors. Our second year, we were able to provide 150 scholarships.

Blue Slipper Program supports the widows of Master Masons. The program aims to improve the lives of the widows by providing assistance for dental and medical services and accessibility modifications. Additionally, the program helps with essential services such as counseling, durable medical equipment, food, clothing and utilities.
